## BIOSECURITY ALERT - JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS DETECTED IN QUEENSLAND, NEW SOUTH WALES AND VICTORIA

Japanese encephalitis (JE) has recently been detected in Victoria, Queensland and New South Wales. There are currently no detections in Western Australia (WA).

JE is a reportable, zoonotic disease that that can cause reproductive losses and encephalitis in pigs and encephalitis in horses and in rare cases, can cause disease in humans.

The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD) is undertaking surveillance activities and considering other preventative measures with the WA Department of Health and WA industry to reduce the risk of JE entering WA.

DPIRD is requesting veterinarians, pig and horse owners to be highly vigilant for signs of this disease, including unexplained pig abortions, mummifications or stillbirths or neurological signs in either species.
