At 12.01am on Thursday 10 March 2022 WA will transition to a "very high caseload setting".

Under [very high caseload COVID-19 protocols](#) critical workers who are close contacts, but are asymptomatic, will be able to attend work, as a last resort, during their isolation period.

A person who works at a veterinary clinic or veterinary hospital may be classed as a [critical worker](#).
