VERY HIGH CASELOAD SETTING

At 12.01am on Thursday 10 March 2022 WA will transition to a "very high caseload setting".

Under very high caseload COVID-19 protocols critical workers who are close contacts, but are asymptomatic, will be able to attend work, as a last resort, during their isolation period.

A summary of the testing and isolation protocols for critical workers can be found here.

A person who works at a veterinary clinic or veterinary hospital may be classed as a <u>critical</u> worker.

Employers need to register for critical worker furloughing settings.
